- 4. The required deposit may be made either by the deposit of any legal tender, by means of a banker's draft or, with the Acting Returning Officer's consent, in any other manner (including the electronic transfer of funds)
- 5. If the election is contested the poll will take place on Thursday, 8th June 2017.
- Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes and amendments or cancellations of proxy votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Town Hall, The Parade, Epsom, Surrey, KT18 5BY by 5pm on Tuesday, 23rd May 2017.
- 7. New applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Town Hall, The Parade, Epsom, Surrey, KT18 5BY by 5pm on Wednesday, 31st May 2017.
- 8. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election on grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Town Hall, The Parade, Epsom, Surrey, KT18 5BY by 5pm on Thursday, 8th June 2017. The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5pm on Wednesday, 31st May 2017. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5pm on Wednesday, 31st May 2017.
