Your handy guide to your new
recycling and refuse collections

This is a notice under Sections 46(1) and 46(4)(d) of the Environmental Protection Act 1990



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What goes in each bin **now**?

Green recycling bin

Collected every week

Yes please

- paper and cardboard
- cans
- cartons, such as drinks and soup cartons
- all plastics, such as plastic bottles, tubs, trays, pots, blister packs, plastic bags
- please put textiles, clothes, shoes and accessories in a sealed, clearly labelled bag by the side of your bin



No glass/no food Glass goes in your kerbside box so it can't smash and damage other recycling. Put food in your caddy

Kerbside box

Collected every week

Yes please

- glass bottles and jars of any colour



You don't need your blue bag now – please recycle it. If you want to keep your box hat, tie it on because we can't replace it.

No thanks Anything else. It's just for glass

Black refuse bin



Collected every week

You'll no longer need your nappy bin, just put nappies in your weekly refuse bin.

No food / no recyclables Use your food caddy and recycling containers
No open lids. No side waste

Food waste bin

Collected every week

Yes please

All food waste cooked or uncooked, such as:

- plate scrapings
- meat and fish
- bones
- fruit and vegetables
- gravy

You can line your caddy with plastic bags or liners, or compostable liners if you prefer.



No thanks Any other packaging, bulk liquids like milk or drinks
