

The Sports and Leisure Council may award grants of up to £500 for clubs and £300 for individuals.

Grants can support:

- Individuals seeking to compete or train at a higher level in their chosen sport
- Clubs towards the purchase of additional equipment
- Sponsorship towards the cost of competing
- Individuals purchase sports equipment
- Clubs towards delivering new sporting that meet the needs of the Borough.

Sportivate

Sportivate is a Sport England National Lottery funding stream aimed at community organisations to attract and sustain 14-25 year olds in sport and physical activity. Sportivate funding can support new sporting initiatives by funding initial costs associated with facility hire, coaching and equipment.

Satellite Clubs

Satellite Clubs are extensions of community sports clubs known as hub clubs. They can be established at community venues such as a secondary school or college and specifically target the 14-25 age group. Coaches and volunteers, linked to the community hub club, work in partnership with the satellite host venue to create a new, sustainable, community satellite club. Thanks to Sport England National Lottery funding, Active Surrey can provide start-up funding to establish the new club sessions.

GLL Sport Foundation (GSF) supports the next generation of sporting athletes to develop and achieve their sporting dreams. GSF support helps young athletes bridge the difficult leap from regional to national level and prepare for senior competition by providing invaluable financial and training support.

To be considered eligible for support athletes must:

- live within a local authority area/public sector partnership where GLL or partners manage sport or leisure venues
- or be educated (school, college, university) within a local authority/public sector partnership where GLL or partners manage sport and leisure venues
- or be affiliated to a club that has a training base at a GLL or partner managed sport and leisure venue.

Surrey Playing Fields

The Surrey County Playing Fields Association is a registered charity which operates under the name Surrey Playing Fields (SPF). It covers the eleven districts and boroughs in the County of Surrey. It is a purely voluntary organisation which has no paid staff.

SPF's main objective is to ensure that there are sufficient areas to play in appropriate places in the County. This covers areas for sport, children's play and for informal play. SPF provide small grants of up to £1,000 and larger loans, planning advice and together with its partners, technical advice.

The Association believes that a well maintained and well used playing field is unlikely to be lost. Accordingly, they provide financial support and advice to those organisations which use the facility. SPF also provide a good link for putting fields into trust so that if a facility is lost it must be replaced with one of equal or better quality. SPF do not provide money for running costs. SPF do provide financial support for the improvement of facilities and for training individuals to take part in assisting clubs.
