Citizens of the European Union can vote at Local elections and European Parliamentary elections only.

*Please note that citizens of Cyprus & Malta are already eligible to vote at all elections under their membership of the Commonwealth.

Citizens of the European Union are entitled to register to vote at local government elections in the UK despite the fact that the UK is no longer a member of the European Union. To register for local government elections EU citizens must complete an ITR Form or register on-line at www.gov.uk/register-to-vote. They **cannot vote** at ordinary UK Parliamentary elections. If they wish to vote at European Parliamentary elections they can no longer do so in the UK they will have to vote in their Home member state.

Note: The Gambia is now back in the Commonwealth as of Friday 22 June 2018. The Maldives removed with effect from May 2017.
