child (16yrs or under). Day Courses £20

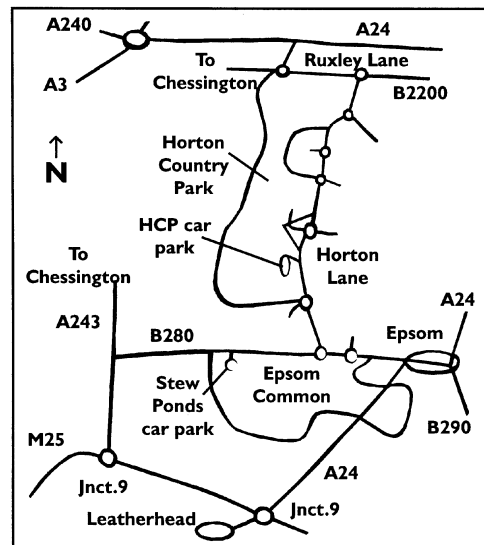
