General Info

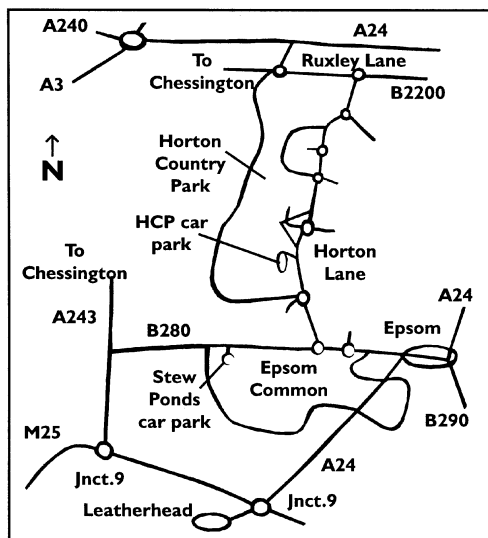
- All walks take approximately 2.5 to 3 hrs and can cover up to 3 miles.

- Please leave your dog at home on walks that involve looking for animals; otherwise they are welcome on a lead.
- Please note that walks may be subject to cancellation due to poor weather conditions.
