Who can join the service?

All households can join (if you live in a flat you may wish to share communal bins). Not available to businesses.

What can I recycle?



- grass cuttings
- small twigs and branches
- leaves
- prunings and clippings
- flowers
- straw and hay

What can't I recycle?

We cannot recycle branches thicker than your wrist, or non-organic waste such as pots, trays, soil, stones. To comply with food waste regulations we cannot recycle **any** kitchen waste, even if grown in your own garden.

When will my recycling be collected?

Garden waste is collected **fortnightly** on your normal collection day. There is a two-week break in service at Christmas and New Year.

How much will it cost?

240 litre brown bin
£56.50 per year or
£51.50 if paid by Direct Debit

A discount of 50% is available to recipients of certain means-tested benefits. If you wish to receive this discount please visit the Town Hall to join the service as we will require sight of original documentation to confirm your eligibility.

Subscriptions are based on a 12 month non-refundable agreement. We will contact you at the end of that time to enquire whether you wish to continue the service for a further year's subscription.

Are assisted collections available for the elderly or disabled?

Yes. Please advise us of your requirements when you join.

- If there are any changes to the amount, date or frequency of your Direct Debit Epsom & Ewell Borough Council will notify you 10 working days in advance of your account being debited or as otherwise agreed. If you request Epsom & Ewell Borough Council to collect a payment, confirmation of the amount and date will be given to you at the time of the request.
- If an error is made in the payment of your Direct Debit, by Epsom & Ewell Borough Council or your bank or building society, you are entitled to a full and immediate refund of the amount paid from your bank or building society.
- If you receive a refund you are not entitled to, you must pay it back when Epsom & Ewell Borough Council asks you to.
- You can cancel a Direct Debit at any time by simply contacting your bank or building society. Written confirmation may be required. Please also notify us.
