What is the Specsavers Surrey Youth Games?

The Specsavers Surrey Youth Games (SSYG) is a multi-sports competition that takes place over two days. All eleven boroughs and districts in Surrey enter teams into 13 different sports. There are events for young people aged between 6 and 16. This includes an event for young people with a disability. The Games are aimed at young people new to a sport. It is a fantastic opportunity to try something new and have the chance to take part in an Olympics style competition at the same time!

What does being a SSYG Young Ambassador involve?

As a SSYG Young Ambassador you will help to promote the Games at your school. The main role of a Young Ambassador is to encourage as many people as possible to sign up for the Games. You will be supported with promotional material including flyers, posters and a DVD. Working together with the Council's Leisure Developments team, you will be helping to increase the awareness of the event. You will also be helping more young people find out about how they can take part in free training sessions. This then gives them the chance to represent Team Epsom and Ewell in the finals weekend!

Why are SSYG Young Ambassadors important?

Young Ambassadors can inspire other young people to try a new sport. We can all make an impression on the people around us. Think about how many times one of our friends may have told us about a new song, a film or the latest App. Many times, they will encourage us to want to go and listen to the song, watch the film or try out the App for ourselves. If you are enthusiastic and passionate about something, you can inspire others to want to find out more. This is what being a great Young Ambassador is all about. Even if you have not taken part in the Games before you may love playing sports or be positive about trying something new! A passionate Young Ambassador will be more effective than any poster or DVD.

How can you become a Young Ambassador in 2019?

- Students must be in school years 5-11
- Applications open to students on Friday 11th January. Students must complete the application form overleaf and return it to Lilley Kennedy at Epsom & Ewell Borough Council by midnight by Sunday 24th February.

A maximum of four Young Ambassadors will be selected from each school. Applicants will find out if they have been successful by **Tuesday 26th February**.
